Mossyrock School District's first graduating class was the class of 1914. Since then the pride and spirit of the first graduate has inspired each generation to push themselves further in their accomplishments and commitments to education.

Mossyrock School is located in the eastern part of Lewis County and is 60 miles from the State Capitol in Olympia, Washington. The schools, the athletics and extracurricular activities are at the heart of the community serving approximately 540 Kindergarten through twelfth grade students. There is an Elementary, Junior High, High School and an alternative school, The Academy. The district has 35 teachers and 3 administrators.

Mossyrock School District is proud of the strong faculty who cares about the students and the school culture. The district enjoys immense support from area business owners and community members in the form of college scholarships which are administered by the Mossyrock Viking Fund. The district is appreciative of civic groups who support the district and community in various ways including promoting tourism and other business ventures. The area is the ancestral land of the Cowlitz and Klickitat Native American Tribes.

The area is well-known for recreational opportunities and for providing a welcoming atmosphere to visitors and residents who enjoy the outdoor activities. Residents and visitors enjoy fishing, camping, hiking, skiing at White Pass, hang gliding, horse riding trails. Also, near-by Mt. Rainer and Mt. St. Helens are popular and favorite recreational areas. The influence of the nearby Dams of Riffe and Mayfield, has transformed the wild Cowlitz River into two recreational lakes, Riffe Lake and Lake Mayfield. Mossyrock is a community that values and honors family, education, its history and takes pride in looking to the future.
