

Our Community

The Town of Kittitas, located in central Washington State, offers the charm of a close-knit rural community with the advantage of a central location that makes both small-town living and diverse regional experiences possible. Just southeast of Ellensburg in the upper Yakima River Valley, Kittitas is framed by the Cascade Mountains to the west and the Columbia River to the east, creating a landscape that is both scenic and accessible.

With a population of just over 1,100, Kittitas provides a welcoming environment where families and neighbors know one another, while the broader Kittitas County community expands the opportunities for work, culture, and recreation. Kittitas District Snapshot

The Kittitas School District is nestled in the heart of central Washington's agricultural region and is proud of its strong tradition of academic achievement, athletic success, and community support. With close-knit schools and a deep commitment to preparing students for success beyond graduation, Kittitas exemplifies how a community can come together to support education and citizenship.

The district serves approximately **571 students from PreK–12** on a single, cohesive campus in Kittitas. Students come from Kittitas proper, Vantage, Badger Pocket, and other rural areas of East Kittitas County. The district is governed by a **five-member elected board of directors** and supported by a dedicated administrative team and approximately **78 staff members**.

Kittitas Elementary School serves about 261 students with a student-teacher ratio of 13:1, while Kittitas High School serves about 307 students with a ratio of 16:1. Overall, the district maintains a ratio of 15.9 students per teacher, allowing for meaningful connections between staff and students and a supportive learning environment.

The district is known for its **championship athletic programs, rich academic tradition, and strong community pride**, making it an inviting place for educational leaders who want to make a lasting impact in a thriving small-school setting.
